SPEAKER'S BIO

TOM VAN KUREN is the Technical Director at Watson Standard where he currently leads the lab responsible for the development, commercialization and technical support of coatings for rigid metal packaging. He received his B.S. degree in Chemistry with a Biochemistry concentration from the University of Cincinnati. For 30 years he has been directly involved in coatings formulation and commercialization, advancing from bench chemist through various supervisory roles and technical management. Prior to Watson Standard, he spent over 17 years at Valspar in the Packaging Coatings Group where he most recently held the position of Technical Manager, Beverage End Coatings. Tom also held several formulation and technical leadership positions developing industrial coil coatings at Sherwin Williams, AkzoNobel, and PPG. He is a member of the PSCT and the International Metal Decorators Association (IMDA). Additionally, he has several patents, has presented papers at international conferences and frequently provides "Coatings 101" training for many of his customers.

ABSTRACT

Food cans were invented to feed Napoleon's troops over 200 years ago. Today they feed the world. Food and beverage can designs continue to evolve to satisfy consumer preferences, improve sustainability and environmental impact, strengthen product branding, comply with changing regulations and improve production efficiency. Many of the innovations in metal packaging would not be possible without the contribution of the polymeric coatings that are applied to the interior and exterior surfaces. This presentation will provide an overview of the broad variety of metal packaging currently used for food and beverages and will discuss the factors that drive change and innovation in packaging design. The types of coatings used and their role in the overall package performance will also be explained. This will include application and cure of the coatings, as well as fabrication, handling, filling, processing and transportation of the filled package. The impact of these performance requirements on the decision processes involved in raw material selection will be discussed. The talk will close with a look towards the future and potential new requirements for packaging coatings and their raw materials and the need for new areas of technical expertise.
